Topic: the significance of repentance and baptism

**Read Luke 3:1-14**

- What does this scripture tell us about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit?
- According to verse 3, what is “a baptism of repentance”? *(There was nothing strange about baptism; this was a common ritual for gentiles who wanted to become Jews. But for a Jew to be baptized they were showing a separation from God and a true repentance and dedication to the Lord)*
- What is John’s definition of repentance? And what is the fruit of a repentant heart? –Gal. 5:22- ff
- As John specifically answer the question “what shall we do” for the crowd, tax collector, and the soldier. What fruit is God looking for in your life? “What shall you do”?
- What area(s) do you feel that you need to repent of? Are there areas of sin that you continually accept and live with? 1 John 1:9
